SPOTLIGHT ON LEARNING- THE GLEN HILLS ORCHESTRA HAS BEEN HARD AT WORK!

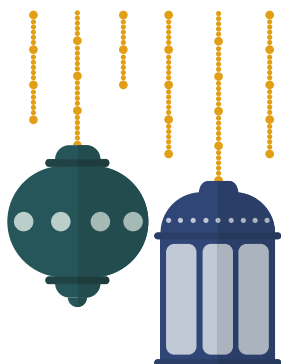

Scholars at Glen Hills Middle School will soon be participating in the Wisconsin State Assessment called the Forward Exam. This exam measures the knowledge and skills your child(ren) have acquired by the time they reach each grade level.

All Wisconsin public school students in Grades 3-8 and 10 are expected to participate in this exam during the Spring testing window as per state statute. The results of these tests will be used in a variety of ways, including:

- Helping school staff make determinations about how to best support your student(s). (Performance on the assessment will not affect any student's current course grades.)
- Assisting the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction to determine each school's Annual State School Report Card. Grade and district level performance, as well as other indicators, are used to calculate the district and school report card.
- Assisting the United States Department of Education to determine each district's Annual Federal Accountability Rating. This takes into account student performance and participation rates.

Glen Hills Middle School is scheduled to take the Wisconsin Forward Exam during the dates listed below.
